Linden Summer Happening Flea Market Rules and Regulations

Rental Spaces

- Rental spaces are 10 X 10 feet and will be pre-determined by the Flea Market chairperson prior to Friday. Upon arrival, check in with the chairperson for your location assignment.
- The cost of a 10 X 10 foot space is **\$50.00 for the (2) days.**
- Setup time begins at 1:00pm on Friday and you should be open for business no later than 3:00pm. Teardown on Saturday evening anytime after 8:00pm. (ps Fireworks at 10:00pm).
- Please stay within your designated space and keep your space clean and attractive.
- You must supply their own furniture, i.e.: tables & chairs, pop-up tents.
- No stakes may be driven into the black top street pavement.

Additional Rules and Regulations

- Each year Summer Happening, Inc. contracts a single glow/light emitting product vendor, therefore sales of glow/light emitting products will not be permitted.
- Flea Market operators are responsible for their own sales tax and permits required by local, state, and federal governmental agencies. Crafters will abide by all applicable Michigan laws.
- Once your application is received and approved by the chairperson, the application fee becomes non-refundable, regardless of your attendance. Should your application be refused, your application fee is returned to you.

General Information

Parking:

- Once you have unloaded your product, please move your vehicle to one of our designated locations.

Electricity:

- This is a Flea Market; we do not normally supply electrical needs. If electrical is required, please note this requirement on your return application; be specific about voltage, connection type and amperage required.

Pedestrians:

- The walkways at the craft show area must be kept clear for the passage of your customers and for state required handicap access.

Refuse:

- Flea Market Operators are responsible for their own trash and policing of their area. Convenient trash containers are located throughout the festival area.
